Do you like being able to borrow rather than buy books? How about checking out a GoPro or yard equipment or musical instruments? All of this is at risk right now. Measure E, which extends **but does not increase** the library parcel tax is on the November ballot and must pass by 2/3 vote. And even though only city residents can vote on this measure, all of us will be impacted if it fails. County branches will be impacted as well as the city branches—less staff, shorter hours or fewer days, and fewer books and other materials.

The campaign season is short—less than 70 days to get the message out and encourage folks to vote yes on Measure E. We need your help in order to achieve a successful result and keep our libraries open 5 days a week.
